OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

There will be no parking in the Student Parking lot as there will be workers sweeping in there. There is ample parking around the perimeter of the school. **THERE IS NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON THESE GROUNDS.**

Transfers will be allowed. The request for a transfer must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Movement between an "A" class and "B" class at the same level is not considered a move up and is not allowed.

BITCHES who come into season after the close of entries but before the start of the trial will be refunded the entry fee less a \$5 admin fee. The owner must provide a veterinary statement written on their vet's stationary and the Final Confirmation more than 30 minutes before the start of the trial. Refunds requested after the start of the trial will NOT be given for any reason. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the exceptions above) or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
 - Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
 - Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
 - The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
 - The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
 - The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
 - The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
 - The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
 - Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
 - Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
 - Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
 - Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
 - Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
 - Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
 - Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
